The offer is valid with a fully paid admission and is not to be combined with any other offers. This complimentary admission is good any day between 9 am-5 pm for up to three months from the original purchase date.

Attracting over 500,000 visitors a year, the Dallas Arboretum is continually listed among the most beautiful public gardens in America. With display gardens that change throughout the year, guests are assured the finest in botanical vistas and photographic opportunities which have also been featured by major magazines across the nation.

In the changing weather of North Texas, it may be raining in North Dallas but dry at White Rock Lake. Weather predictions may make a family skeptical when making entertainment plans but this way they have a

Dallas Arboretum and Botanical Garden is located on the Southeastern shore of White Rock at 8525 Garland Road, Dallas, TX, 75218. The Arboretum is open daily from 9am until 5pm. General Admission is \$10 for adults, \$9 for seniors 65 and older, \$7 for children 3-12, and free for two and under. On-site parking is \$7. The Arboretum is wheelchair accessible and tram service is available for the mobility impaired. Group discounts are available with advance registration.
